



Families who had children in the program last year, should receive a letter in the mail before the end of the summer. If your child attends Catholic School



What do we mean by Christian Initiation?

Christian Initiation is the process through which an unbaptized person over the age of 7 or a non-Catholic enters fully into the divine life of the Church. The process includes several stages marked by study, prayer and rites at Mass. Participants undergo a process of conversion as they study the Scriptures, profess faith in Jesus and the Catholic Church, and receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist.
