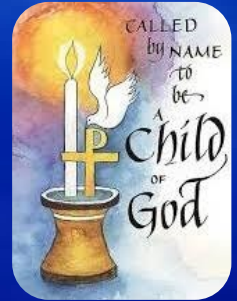

### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

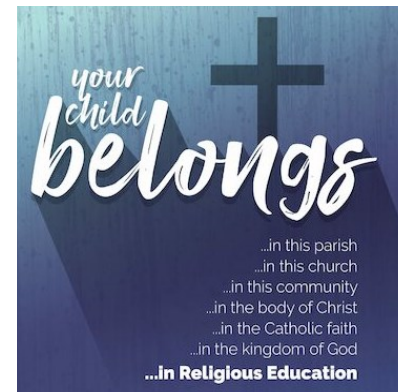
### ATTENTION PARENTS

**Sunday, August 6th at 9:20am** or **Tuesday, August 8th at 7pm**

*Families who had children in the program last year, should receive a letter in the mail before the end of the summer. If your child attends Catholic School and needs sacramental preparation, please contact Gina Savko in the parish office. The Diocese requires that children and youth receive two years of formal preparation prior to receiving First Communion and Confirmation. Children over the age of 7 who are not baptized must go through the RCIA program in order to receive the sacraments.*

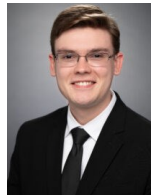

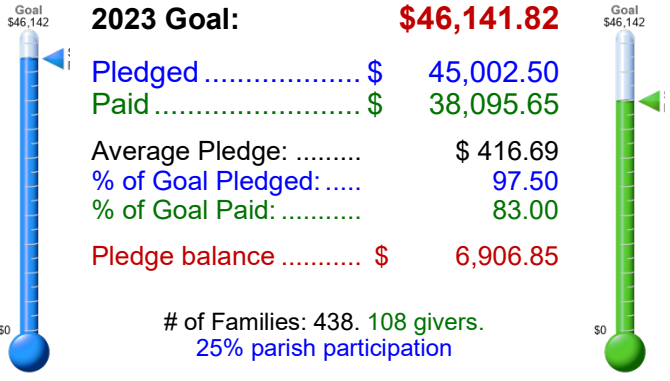

### Tax Free Charitable Distribution from your IRA Account at age 70½!

Congress has permanently enacted qualified charitable distributions from your traditional IRA accounts. These distributions can be used to satisfy all or a portion of your Required Minimum Distribution. These distributions are free of federal and state income tax. Additionally, these gifts help you avoid the Medicare high income surcharge and can help to reduce taxes on your social security benefits.

### What do we mean by Christian Initiation?

Christian Initiation is the process through which an unbaptized person over the age of 7 or a non-Catholic enters fully into the divine life of the Church. The process includes several stages marked by study, prayer and rites at Mass. Participants undergo a process of conversion as they study the Scriptures, profess faith in Jesus and the Catholic Church, and receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist.

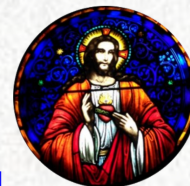
